



History Theatre Message to our Audiences

For your Safety and Comfort

We are excited to welcome audiences back to History Theatre!

To ensure your health and safety, the following protocols will be in place until further notice for the coming season, which opens on October 14, 2021.



Masks Required

All audience, artists and staff members will be masked regardless of vaccination status.



Vaccinations Required

All audience members, artists and staff members must be fully vaccinated and be able to provide proof (digital or paper) of COVID-19 vaccination. Fully vaccinated means that you have completed your vaccine, whether it's one dose or two, and the final dose was received at least 14 days prior to the performance you are attending.

Any audience members who are unable to be vaccinated may provide a negative COVID-19 test administered within 72 hours of the performance they are attending.

If you are not able to meet these mask and vaccination requirements or are experiencing any symptoms, we are happy to:

- **exchange your tickets;** OR
- **offer you the choice to stream a video of the full production** (*limited streaming dates*)

We understand that these protocols are not an ideal way to experience live theatre. Given the uncertainties in the current public health environment, we THANK YOU in advance for helping us start off the season with the highest standards to prevent the spread of COVID-19 among audiences, artists, staff, and volunteers. We are all in this together and be assured that we will adapt and update these policies as the environment changes. Many of our theatre colleagues in the Twin Cities are adapting similar protocols.

What to expect when you attend a performance at History Theatre

- All patrons will check in (one of two) tables located in lobby with their vaccination card.
- The box office will open 60 minutes before each performance.
- Please plan to arrive early to ease congestion in the lobby.
- Please bring your printed tickets to avoid unnecessary contact with the box office.
- No food or drink will be allowed in the theatre and no concessions will be sold.
- Advanced cleaning protocols will be used throughout the theatre and masks and hand sanitizer will be available.
