First and foremost, thank you to Rick Thompson and History Theatre for inviting "Handprints" into this historic space. And to Marcela Lorca who championed and nurtured this piece from its infancy to the full film production of *Handprints* in 2021.

In 2012 I wrote a book entitled "Mama 'n 'Nem, Handprints On My Life" (Kirk House). After reading the book, Joe Dowling (former Artistic Director of Guthrie Theater) said, "Greta! These characters are so evocative. They're moving. And they're so funny! You should write a One-Woman-Show!

Three years would go by before I picked up a pen to write the first draft. I cherry picked scenes from my favorite chapters. First draft done. It was a play, but just random scenes. It needed a beginning, middle and end. It needed a theme, a through-line. As a writer, sometimes it's hard to delete words you've fallen in love with. I edited. I made crucial cuts and revisions. What started as a One-Woman-Show, is now a Two-Hander with live accompaniment.

Handprints features my mother, an aunt, and other people influential in my life. But it ultimately became a story about my relationship with my father, whose legacy continues to inform and define my life's journey.

I hope you are deeply moved, you laugh hysterically, and that you are ultimately swept away by these ordinary yet extraordinary people.

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
















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
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
